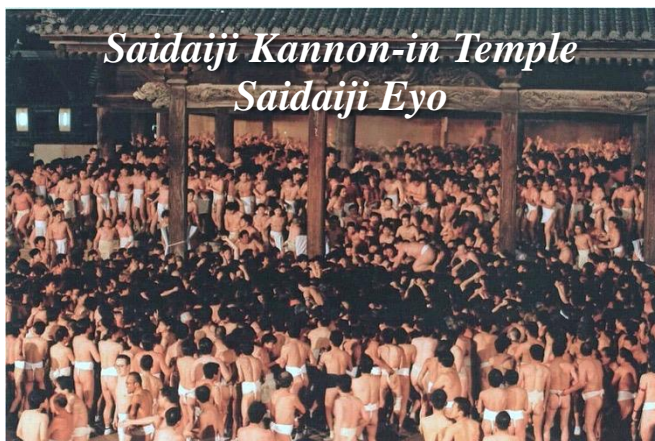

Known as one of Japan's three oddest festivals, the Saidaiji Eyo is a Buddhist festival that has continued for over 500 years. This year it was designated as an important intangible folk cultural asset of Japan.
