Dates: August 1 (Wed.) – August 31 (Fri.) Time: 6:00 PM – 9:30 PM



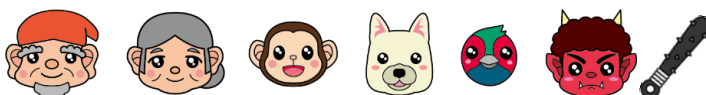
